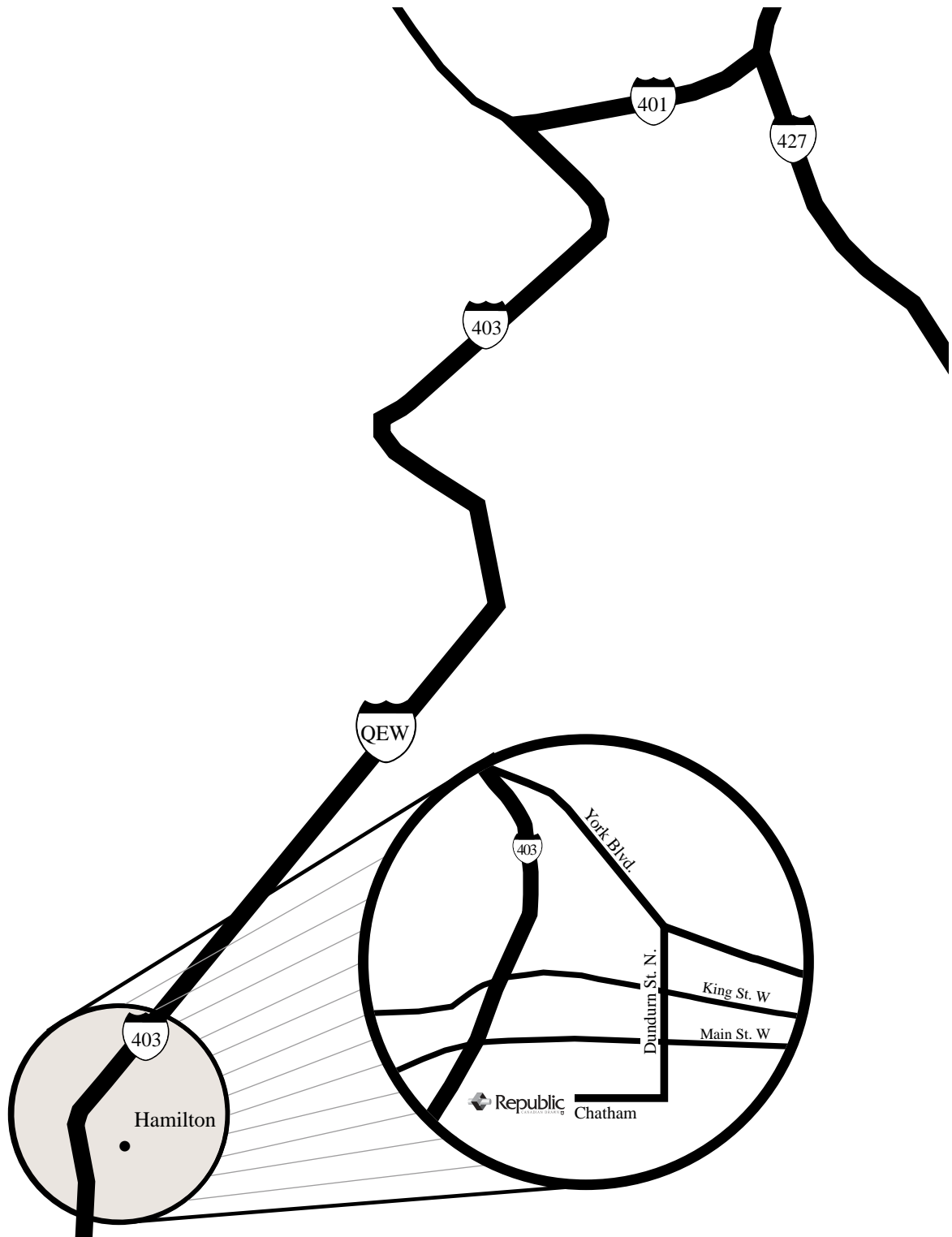

From Toronto/Pearson International Airport (Approx. 45 minutes):

From the airport take Hwy. 427 to Hwy. 401 West, to Hwy. 403 (Hamilton), to Queen Elizabeth Way, to Hwy. 403 (Brantford). Exit on York Boulevard. Turn right at the first light (Dundurn St. N.). Go through the next two lights (King St. and Main St.) and take the next right after the lights onto Chatham St. The plant is on the left, past the railway bridge.

From Fort Erie, Canada and Buffalo, NY (Approx.. 1 hour, 15 minutes):

Cross the Peace Bridge at Buffalo/Fort Erie. The Queen Elizabeth Way to Hamilton/Toronto. Follow Queen Elizabeth Way to Hwy. 403 (Brantford/London), and take Hwy. 403 to Hamilton. Exit on York Boulevard. Turn right at the first light (Dundurn St. N.). Go through the next two lights (King St. and Main St.) and take the next right after the lights onto Chatham St. The plant is on the left, past the railway bridge.

From Hamilton Airport:

Out of the airport parking lot, turn right on Airport Rd. Follow Airport Rd to Fiddler's Green Rd. Turn right, and follow Fiddler's Green Rd. to Hwy. 403. Take Hwy. 403 to Hamilton. Exit on Main E. Turn right at the first light (Dundurn St.). Take the next right onto Chatham St. The plant is on the left, past the railway bridge.
